THE INFLUENCE OF A PARENT

Parents have a very powerful influence on their children. Like mother like daughter (Eze. 16:44); and father like son. Typically, unless children are determined to be different in the flaws of their parents, they turn out the same. Recently, Dr. Paul Chappell wrote an article called, "7 WAYS PARENTS UNDERMINE THEIR OWN INFLUENCE." (Ministry127.com) Consider a brief description regarding how parents can hurt their influence:

1. When children hear their parents criticize authority. If you criticize your boss every night after work or complain about the bible class teacher, preacher or church leaders every Sunday at lunch, "[h]earing you disrespect authorities – no matter how justified it seems or how much your children agree with you – plants seeds of disrespect in their hearts."

2. When children see their parents violating Scripture. This is not to say that parents are to be perfect. However, there is a difference between seeking to live a godly life and falling short and repeatedly telling kids to act one way, only to do the opposite.

3. When children feel their parents do not love one another. "The seeds of insecurity sown in a young person's heart when she feels her parents don't love each other run deep...No matter how many times you tell your children that it's not their fault that you can't get along with your spouse, they won't believe you – not down deep."

4. When children are not disciplined for disobedience. If you make a rule, and they break it, and only threaten and not punish, you'll eventually lose their respect for the your boundaries and your words.

5. When children are rewarded materially in spite of bad behavior. The idea of, "If I just keep giving stuff to my child, he'll really love me," he notes, "The truth is, your teen will not love you more for what you buy him; he will enjoy what you buy, but he will lose respect for you when he knows you won't ever tell him 'no.'"

6. *When children are compensated materially by parents who pity them.* "Giving your children gifts, yes. If your teenager, however, is always asking for money, but is unwilling to work, or to budget and you keep giving her money, she loses respect for you...They will learn to see you as a financial source to manipulate rather than a loving provider and teacher."
