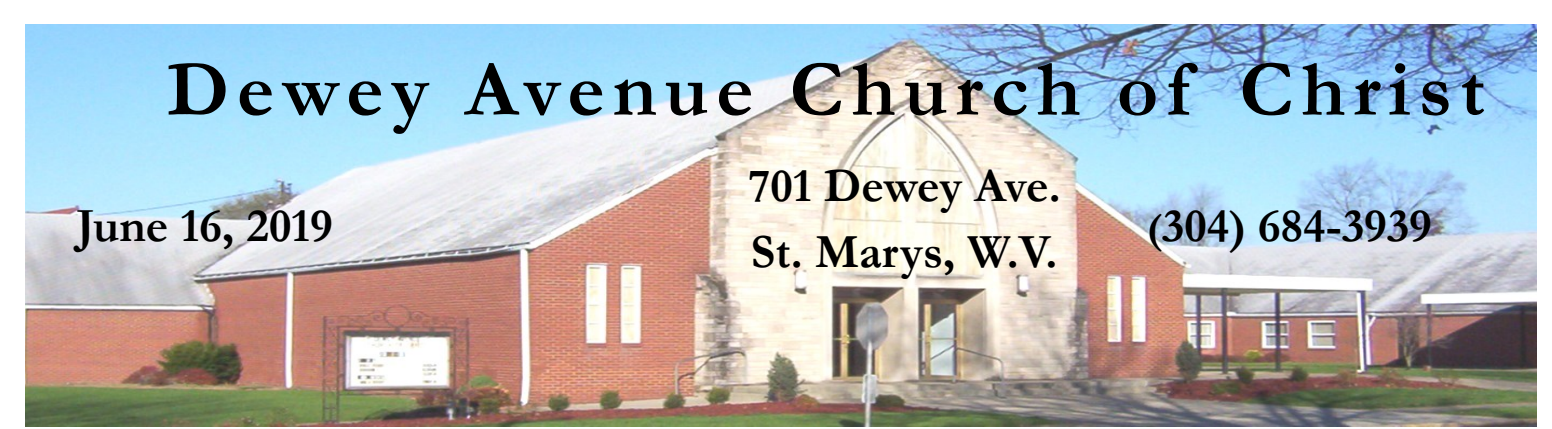

Premillennialism and the Book of Hebrews

In regard to the end of times, almost all of my denominational friends hold to a view called “Premillennialism.” Which teaches that Jesus was not successful in establishing an earthly kingdom when here the first time, thus, God was forced to set up the church as “plan B,” or an after-thought. As a result, they believe Christ will one day return to this earth and set up this earthly kingdom to reign for a literal 1,000 years. Following this will be the Judgment/end of the world and then eternity.

I’ll be the first to admit that Premillennialism is pretty complex to study. This belief literally reinterprets the whole Bible. However, there are many problems with it and here’s one: at the heart of the Premillennial theory is the re-institution of Judaism. The offering of animal sacrifices, burning of incense, rebuilding of the temple, the Old Testament system of the priesthood, etc., are things Premillennialist’s believe will be reestablished when Christ allegedly returns as an earthly King. The main problem with this is that an entire book in the New Testament was written to condemn such error – the book of Hebrews. The writer of Hebrews was dealing with Christians of Jewish descent who were becoming unfaithful to God by going back into Judaism. This book shows that the New Covenant is better than the Old Covenant. Christianity is superior to Judaism and it was part of God’s original plan that Judaism serve a temporary purpose, primarily to bring us to Christ (Galatians 3:16-27). Hebrews teaches us that in Christ, we have a better high priest, a better sacrifice, a better reward etc.

Any system of doctrine that wants to reinstitute something that God did away with is contradictory to God’s own Word.
