*Dan Kessinger's niece April Jordan is struggling and is in need of prayers.

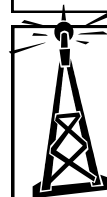
*Melvin & Susan Truax's son Travis and his pregnant wife have covid in Arizona.
