Some of the darkest times of Israelite history came during the days of Elijah. King Ahab, "did evil in the sight of the LORD, more than all who were before him" (1 Kings 16:30). He married Jezebel, a pagan princess and instituted the worship of Baal and Asherah as the new state religion. A three year drought caused a famine and collapsed the economy. The faithful servants and prophets of God were forced into hiding in fear of their lives (1 Kings 18:3-6, 19:18). In spite of all of this, it was actually a time that God revealed His goodness to the people.

The goodness of God is seen in the miracles of God's through the prophet Elijah. He saved the life of a gentile widow by miraculously providing her an endless jar of flour and oil for bread (1 Kings 17:14-16), as well as raising her son from the dead (1 Kings 17:17-24).

As God's primary spokesman or representative to the people, he exposed the foolishness and absurdity of Baal worship on Mount Carmel. One of the idols representing Baal was a bull. Ironically, for several hours the prophets of Baal cried out, danced, and even cut themselves in hopes their idol would miraculously send fire to consume a bull on the altar (1 Kings 18:26-29). Yet God's prophet after soaking everything in water, cried out to God and sent fire down from Heaven, devouring the bull, the altar itself and the water all around (1 Kings 18:38).

The goodness of God can be seen in the discipline of God. God revealed Himself in the fulfillment of prophecy. Years ago, because of the Canaanites' wickedness and rejection of God, He collapsed the walls of Jericho, ensuring the Israelites first victory in the promised land. After Jericho's defeat, Joshua proclaimed a curse on the man who would ever rebuild the city, losing the life of his youngest and oldest sons (Joshua 6:26). Hundreds of years had passed, but in the days of Ahab, Hiel of Bethel rebuilt the city and lost his oldest and youngest sons (1 Kings 16:34).

God revealed Himself in three years of no rain (see 1 Kings 17:1, 18:1,41-45). Why would God do this? Baal was the storm god. He was the one whom the pagans worshiped for rain and in hopes of having a bountiful harvest. When God stopped the rain, the prophets and worshipers of Baal were powerless.

The goodness of God can be seen in the patience of God. The very fact that He still sent prophets and actions of discipline instead of immediate and complete destruction is an act of mercy, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9; 1 Kings 18:37).

No matter how dark and difficult times may come, if we look, the goodness of God will be seen.
