"Take your vitamins and drink your milk," were things I heard as a child that kids needed to do in order to grow. Even though proper nutrition helps, physical growth is a natural process. The same cannot be said when it comes to one's faith and spiritual growth. How does a Christian grow?

In Acts 2, those who responded in faith with repentance and baptism for the forgiveness of sins in being added to the church (verses 38, 47), reveal a pattern for growth in verse 42, "they continued steadfastly in the apostles doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers." Consider some key words from this verse:

"Continued steadfastly"

They developed a habit, a routine. The word in the Greek means "to persist in adherence to a thing" (Mounce, E-Sword). If a person wants to be an elite marathon runner, he must train on a daily basis. He cannot run every so often when he feels like it, taking weeks or months off at a time. Likewise, growing in one's faith requires a consistent effort.

"Apostles doctrine"

They listened and adhered to the teaching of the apostles. Our knowledge of Christ does not stop at the moment of following Jesus. Learning from Jesus and His word is something God's child does for the rest of his life (2 Peter 3:18).

"Fellowship"

This word has several meanings such as communion, partnership and participation. All these words communicate the idea of being together. Regardless of what they were doing, the early church spent time together. Being around other Christians can give encouragement (Acts 28:15), prevent us from being hardened by the deceitfulness of sin (Hebrews 10:24-25); Keeps us accountable with our struggles (James 5:16), and helps us stay faithful (James 5:19-20).

"Breaking of Bread"

This is speaking of the Lord's Supper that the early church participated in on Sunday's (Acts 20:7). The Lord's Supper is a time of reflection on one's own sins and the forgiveness His sacrifice gives us. This was also the time to assemble for worship (Acts 20:7-11).

"Prayers"

Their devotion to prayer is seen in praying before big decisions (Acts 1:24), after being arrested, released and warned not to preach Christ (Acts 4:23-35), selecting deacons (Acts 6:1-6), on behalf for Peter who had been arrested and sentenced to death (Acts 12:12), before they sent out missionaries (Acts 13:1-3), and while in prison (Acts 16:25).

"Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation (3) if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good" (1 Peter 2:2-3).
