Dave Lancaster	Using God-given Ability (v. 14). Timothy had received miraculous powers by the "laying on of hands." The miraculous
Hal Powell	age ceased at the end of the first century (1 Corinthians 13:8-12). Thus, it is by application we learn to use our Godgiven abilities. The Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25) stresses using what God gives us and not squandering it.
Lew Wilson	What God has given, let us use to His glory (1 Corinthians 10:31)!
<u>Deacons</u> :	Purpose Driven Life (v. 15a). We must be entirely committed to holy living. Our purpose will determine our direction
